Squadron Cadet of the Year

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1. Description

The outstanding Cadet of the Year is an annual award established to recognize the most outstanding cadet in each CAP squadron. To be considered, a cadet needs to be in good standing both in CAP and academically in school, progressing admirably in the CAP cadet program, has demonstrated outstanding achievement in community service and the cadet program (aerospace and leadership). The cadet must also be of high moral character, demonstrate a high level of professionalism in appearance, action, and patriotism, actively participating in local squadron meetings and wing events, and demonstrate growth potential (assumes higher levels of responsibility).

The Florida Wing will recognize one outstanding cadet from each squadron. A cadet will be chosen by the squadron leadership and should be one of the cadets that was selected for the wing phase (I – IV) cadet of the year.

2. Selection Process

Every squadron will develop their own process to determine their cadet of the year, as well as their own time line. It is recommended to use the calendar year as the start/stop time for the year.

3. Wing recognition

The wing will recognize one cadet from each squadron as the cadet of the year. That cadet will be authorized to wear a maroon and white cord with maroon the outside color and white the inside color. The cadet is authorized to wear this cord for one year only to the anniversary date of their award, or until they leave CAP or become a senior member as long as the cadet remains in good standing. Should the cadet receive any written disciplinary action or suspension from CAP they may no longer wear the cord. The cadet is allowed to wear this cord on their blues uniform at any event within the Florida Wing.
